Provided your answer to all the questions is negative, you may enter the building. This is subject to the following conditions:

- Admitted are visitors who can prove a **Corona test with a negative result** (an antigen test not older than 24 hours and PCR test not older than 48 hours) or a complete immunisation. All children under 6 years of age are exempt from the said testing requirement. Please consider that on the COVID wards, no regular visits will be possible.
- **Outpatients in need of assistance** can be accompanied by maximum one person. The said accompanying person must also be able to proof to have a 3G. The 3G requirement is only waived in case of emergency escorts and births.
- **All visitors, accompanying and external persons must wear a medical mouth-nose protection** at all times. On the wards with particularly vulnerable patients (for example, intensive care units, oncology, nephrology), FFP2 masks will be mandatory.
- Your **body temperature** may not be higher than 37.5 °C at the time of the visit.
- **Hygienic hand disinfection** must be conducted upon entering and leaving the building, as well as before and after contact with the patient.
- Comply with the **required social distancing rules** (1.5 m) – in particular vis-à-vis third-party patients and members of staff.
- **Avoid physical contact wherever possible** (handshakes, hugs, etc.).
